THE PILGRIMAGE



OMMENCING in 1991, pilgrims have gathered from around the world to make a procession through the Australian countryside from St Patrick's Cathedral, Ballarat to Sacred Heart Cathedral, Bendigo.

While walking the Pilgrims engage in communal prayer and song, as well as personal reflection and meditation. Confession and Mass celebrated using the **1962 Missal** are available to Pilgrims each day.

All meals are generously prepared by volunteers and accommodation is provided in community halls or camping fields. **Children's Chapter** runs throughout the day with activities and catechism for young children and families.

The Pilgrimage concludes with the **Solemn Mass of Christ the King** celebrated at Sacred Heart Cathedral, Bendigo.

The Pilgrimage is organised by the Christus Rex Society - made up of a volunteer group of pilgrims, successors to the original pilgrims, and who are united by their great love of Christ the King.

This year marks 100 years since the introduction of the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, commonly referred to as the Feast of Christ the King by Pope Pius XI in Ouas Primas.
